"The fear of man lays a snare, but whoever trusts in the LORD is safe." -**Proverbs 29:25**

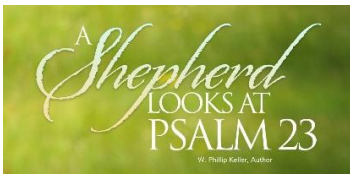
