TONIGHTS BIG IDEA:

Discussion Questions:

3. Think about the first part of verse 1 again; "The Lord is my Shepherd". We can all agree that the Lord is an amazing shepherd, and so perfect to care for us, leading to the fact that we have everything we need. Yet just like sheep, we are prone to wander.
 - What things make *YOU* wander from the Shepherd and cause you to turn your attention away from God?
 - Now that you recognize it, what should you do about it?
