El-Elyon: God Most High

Colossians 1: 15-16, John 1:1

El Shaddai- Promise Keeper

"El Shaddai is our All-Sufficient One, but His name also hints at His character as a Promise Keeper. One author has said, 'Until the time of Moses, when another divine name was revealed, the patriarchs considered El Shadday (or Shaddai) the covenant name of God'." -Mary Wiley
